

June 27, 2020 Novel Coronavirus Case in Tochigi Prefecture (Case No. 69)

Active Epidemiological Investigation (Report No. 2)

June 29, 2020

The confirmed results of the active epidemiological investigation of the case of novel coronavirus (Case 69) declared on June 27 in Tochigi Prefecture are as follows. The information announced today is underlined.

【Patient Summary (Case 69)】

1. Age: 10s

2. Sex: Female

3. Area: Sakura City

4. Symptoms and progression:

June 25 After a customer (resides outside of Tochigi Prefecture) of the nightclub where the patient works (CLUB EIGHT) was confirmed positive, Utsunomiya City was contacted by the Public Health Center in the customer's residential area.

Night of June 25 Utsunomiya City's investigation determined that the patient had been in close contact with the infected customer and requested a test from the prefecture.

June 26 The Prefectural North Health and Welfare Center arranged for the patient to be examined at a medical facility in Sakura City. The patient presented with fever (38°C range), nasal congestion, and pharyngeal pain.

June 27 Tested via PCR and confirmed positive. Hospitalized at a medical facility in Tochigi Prefecture. Currently experiencing fever (37°C range) only.

5. Patient Behavior History

• On June 22, an infected person (diagnosed on June 25) from outside the prefecture visited the nightclub in Utsunomiya where the patient works (CLUB EIGHT) and interacted closely with the patient. The patient wore a mask other than when eating and drinking. The customer from outside the prefecture did not wear a mask.

• On June 23, the patient and one friend spent 8 hours at a karaoke hall in Utsunomiya. They did not wear masks. Afterward, they spent one hour at a restaurant in Utsunomiya. The patient wore a mask other than when eating and drinking; the friend did not wear one.

• Commuted to work by car and public transportation.

#### 6. People in Close Contact with the Patient

- The patient's family members who live with the patient (grandfather, mother, older sister) and two friends were in close contact with the patient. They were tested via PCR on June 29 and all were confirmed negative.

- None in the medical facilities due to appropriate infection prevention measures.

#### 7. Protocol from now on

- Any new people who are identified as having been in close contact with the patient will be tested via PCR and placed on health observation or asked to refrain from going out.
