

June 28, 2020 Novel Coronavirus Case in Tochigi Prefecture (Case No. 73)

Active Epidemiological Investigation (Report No. 3)

July 1, 2020

The confirmed results of the active epidemiological investigation of the case of novel coronavirus (Case 73) declared on June 28 in Tochigi Prefecture are as follows. The information announced today is underlined.

【Patient Summary (Case 73)】

1. Age: 20s
2. Sex: Female

3. Area: Kaminokawa Town

4. Symptoms and progression:

June 27            After cases 67, 68, and 69 were confirmed positive, Utsunomiya City's Public Health Center arranged for the patient to be tested at Utsunomiya City's PCR Testing Center on the basis of having been in close contact with the infected parties.

June 28            Samples taken at the PCR Testing Center. Tested via PCR at the Utsunomiya Hygiene and Environmental Testing Center and confirmed positive. No symptoms present.

June 29            Hospitalized at a medical facility in Tochigi Prefecture.

5. Patient Behavior History

- Went to work at the nightclub CLUB EIGHT from the night of June 22 until the morning of June 23. Did not go to work there after that night.

- Went to work at the nightclub Club 'efu from the night of June 23 until the morning of June 24.

- Commuted via taxi

- June 25            Did not go to work

- June 26            Visited several restaurants in Tochigi Prefecture with a friend at night

- June 27            Visited a business outside of Tochigi Prefecture with a friend while wearing a mask. Went out to eat with several acquaintances at a restaurant in Tochigi Prefecture that night and returned home via a designated driver service.

- In addition to the above, also shopped briefly at a convenience store while wearing a mask.

6. People in Close Contact with the Patient

- One acquaintance was in close contact with the patient. They were tested via PCR on June 29 and confirmed positive (Case 76). Six other people (five acquaintances and the designated driver) were tested on July 1 and confirmed negative.

- None in the medical facilities due to appropriate infection prevention measures.

#### 7. Protocol from now on

- Any new people who are identified as having been in close contact with the patient will be tested via PCR and placed on health observation or asked to refrain from going out.
